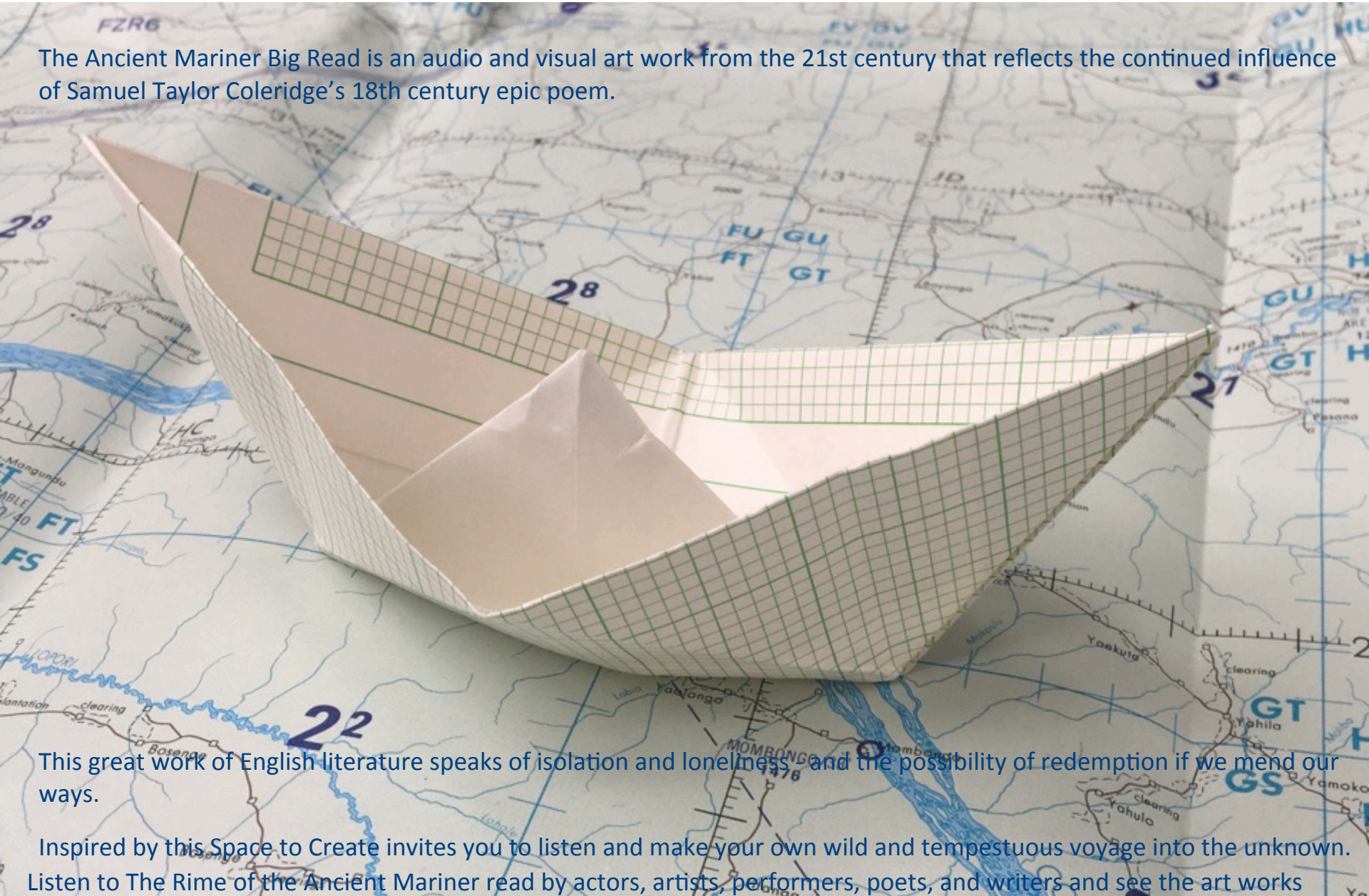

Inspired by The Rime of the Ancient Mariner Big Read we invite you to make your own paper boat and set sail...

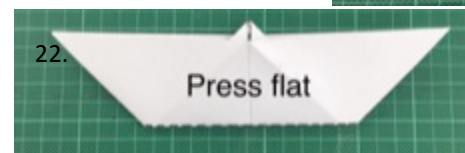
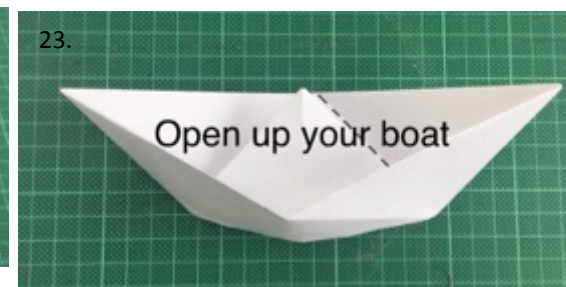
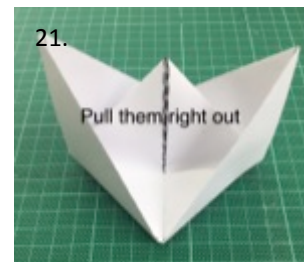
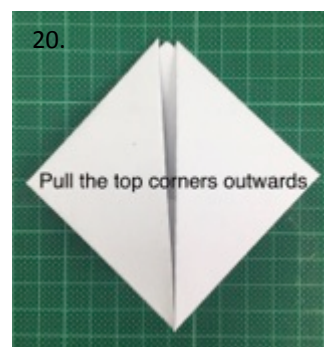
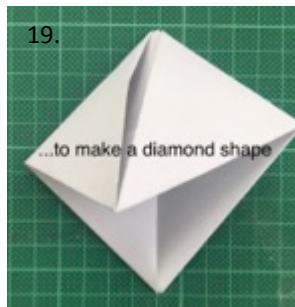
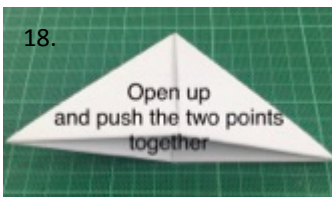
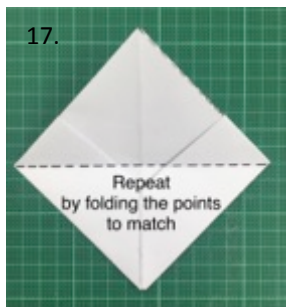
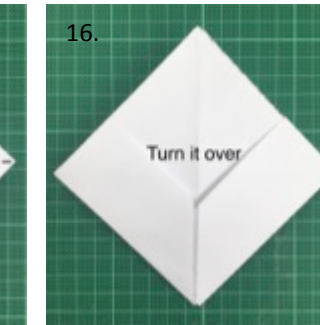
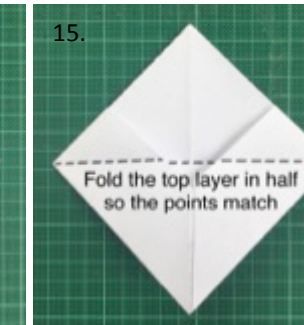
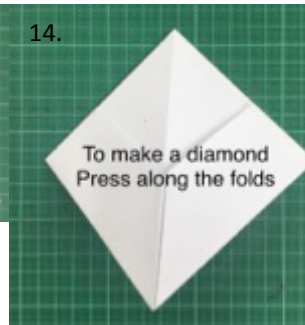
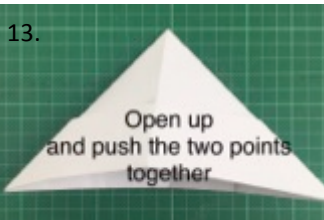
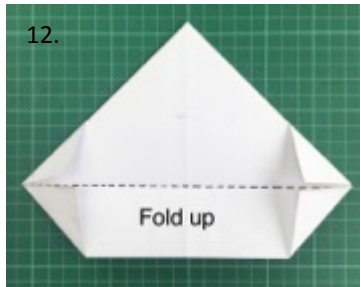
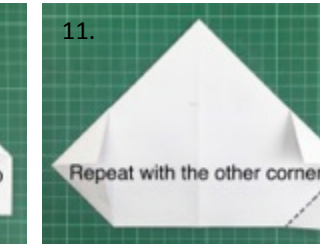
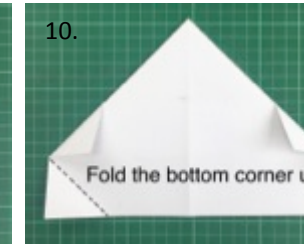
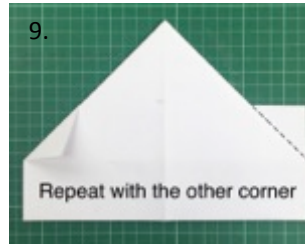
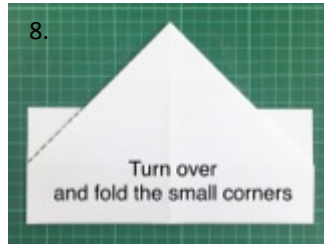
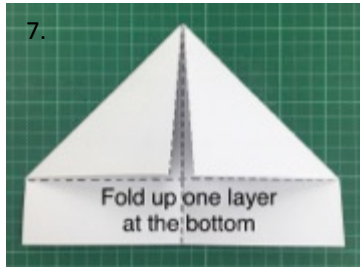
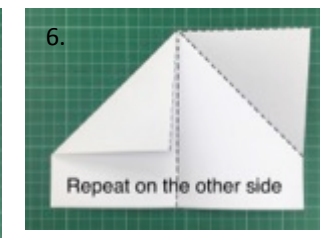
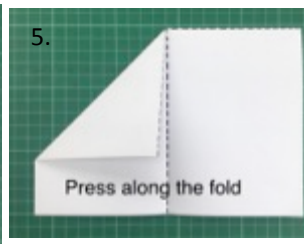
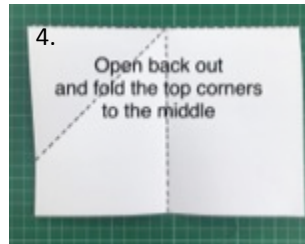
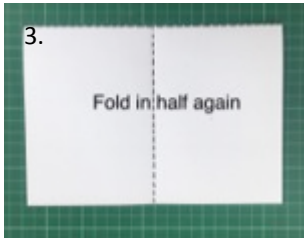
