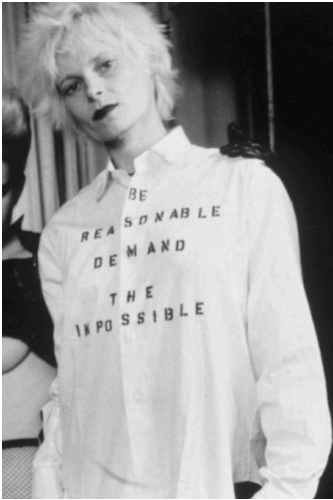

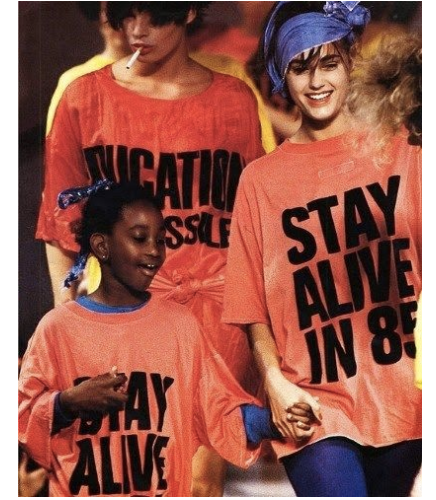

Design your own slogan or logo that shares your ideas on how to make the world a fairer place for everyone.

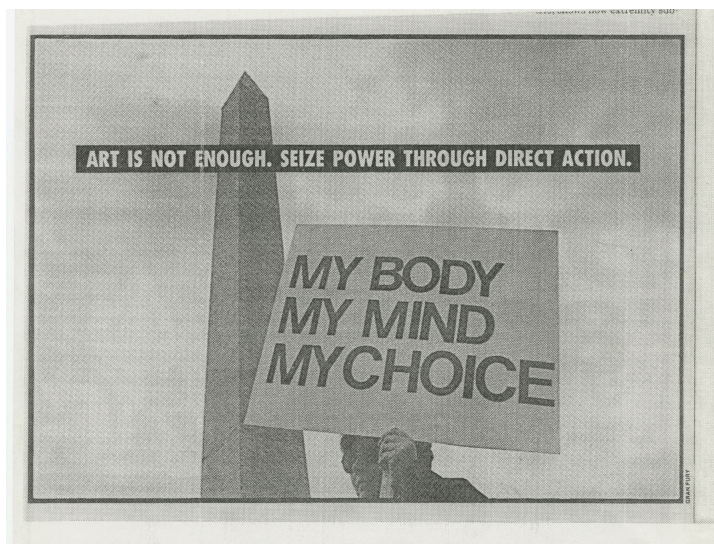
Make a t shirt, banner or flag that shares your ideas with others.

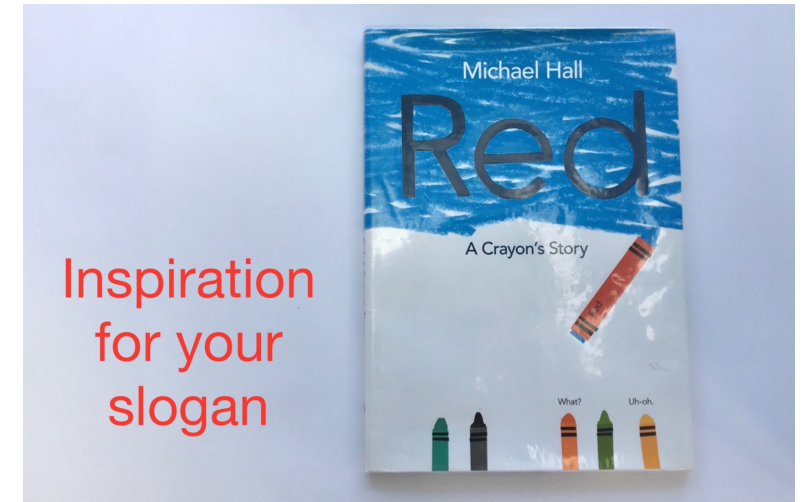
